



The New East Photo Prize Terms and Conditions 2016

Summary:

Submissions for the New East Photo Prize are open from May 18 to August 19, 2016. The shortlisted works will be exhibited at Calvert 22 Foundation's space in London in November-December 2016. The winner of the New East Photo Prize will get a chance to publish a body of work as a photo book for free. The winner of the Special Prize will receive a £1000 grant from Bird in Flight magazine, the official partner of the New East Photo Prize,.

1. Entry is open to citizens of Armenia, Azerbaijan, Belarus, Bosnia & Herzegovina, Bulgaria, Croatia, Czech Republic, Estonia, Georgia, Hungary, Kazakhstan, Kosovo, Kyrgyzstan, Latvia, Lithuania, Macedonia, Moldova, Montenegro, Poland, Romania, Russia, Serbia, Slovakia, Slovenia, Tajikistan, Turkmenistan, Ukraine, Uzbekistan, aged 18 years or over, except for employees of Calvert 22 Foundation. Citizens of the above stated countries residing anywhere in the world are eligible for entry.
2. All information detailing how to enter this competition forms part of these terms and conditions. It is a condition of entry that all rules are accepted as final and that the competitor agrees to abide by these rules. Submission of an entry will be taken to mean acceptance of these terms and conditions.
3. Entries should be submitted via the electronic submission form on the New East Photo Prize's official website: photoprize.calvertjournal.com. Entrants should include their own name, address, telephone number and a short biographical note (up to 200 words long).
4. Photography entries shot on either film or digital cameras are eligible. However, all images submitted must be in digital file format.
5. Entry is free of charge and is open to both professional and amateur photographers.
6. Entrants can submit a project made within the last two years. A project can be a body of images or a motion picture exploring a chosen theme or topic. Each submission must be accompanied by a photographic statement of up to 600 words long. Entrants can submit up to 15 (fifteen) photos.
7. Each image should be at least 72 dpi and between 1MB and 3MB, RGB mode, JPEG in maximum quality.
8. Moving images should be uploaded to YouTube or Vimeo in HD without any passwords. Each video should be no longer than 5 minutes.
9. All images submitted must be that of your or your collective/group's work and you must own the copyright for it. It is your responsibility to ensure that any images you submit have been taken with the permission of the subject and do not infringe the copyright of any third party or any laws.
10. Only one entry per person. Late entries will not be accepted.

11. Copyright and all other rights remain that of the photographer. Any photograph used by Calvert 22 Foundation shall carry the photographer's credit line. Use may include publication in any Calvert 22 Foundation media partner publication.

12. All entrants understand that any image submitted to the competition may be used by Calvert 22 Foundation for marketing and promotional purposes including in any media such as exhibitions, print and digital media directly related to the New East Photo Prize. By winning or participating in the competition you are agreeing to be included in print publications, including the photobook.

13. Neither the New East Photo Prize, Calvert 22 Foundation nor their associates, affiliates, or partners assume any responsibility for photos submitted in violation of prize rules, or for those which violate copyright regulations.

14. Judging of the main prize will consist of three rounds:

* Round 1 - The Longlist: The Creative Director and Editors from The Calvert Journal will select the longlist of works by Friday 2 September 2016.

* Round 2 - The Shortlist: The jury panel will select a shortlist of finalists by Wednesday 14 September 2016. The shortlisted works will be shown at the New East Photo Prize exhibition at Calvert 22 Foundation's space in November-December 2016.

* Round 3 - The Winner: The judges will select a winner who will be announced in December 2016.

15. The winner of the Special Prize dedicated to unfinished documentary projects will be selected by the editorial team of Bird in Flight magazine and will be announced in December 2016. The winner will receive a £1000 grant toward the completion of their project.

17. The shortlisted entrants will be notified by email in September 2016.

18. The judges will select work based on artistic merit. The jury's decision is final and will be published on the official website of the New East Photo Prize. The organiser will not enter into any correspondence regarding the selection of the New East Photo Prize exhibition.

19. The winners may be required to take part in publicity activities.

20. English law applies and the exclusive jurisdiction of the English Courts shall prevail.
